AN ACT

To amend section one hundred of an act approved the thirty-first day of March one thousand eight hundred and sixty (Pamphlet Laws three hundred eighty-two) entitled "An act to consolidate revise and amend the penal laws of this Commonwealth"

1 *Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one hundred of an act approved the thirty-first
5 day of March one thousand eight hundred and sixty
6 (Pamphlet Laws three hundred eighty-two) entitled "An act
7 to consolidate revise and amend the penal laws of this
8 Commonwealth" which reads as follows

9 "Section 100 If any person being armed with an of-
10 fensive weapon or instrument shall rob or assault with
11 intent to rob another or shall together with one or
12 more person or persons rob or assault with intent to

1 rob or shall rob any person and at the same time or
2 immediately before or immediately after such robbery beat
3 strike or ill-use any person or do violence to such per-
4 son the person so offending shall be guilty of felony
5 and being thereof convicted shall be sentenced to pay a
6 fine not exceeding one thousand dollars and undergo an
7 imprisonment by separate or solitary confinement at labor
8 not exceeding ten years" is hereby amended to read as
9 follows

10 Section 100 If any person being armed with an of-
11 fensive weapon or instrument shall rob or assault with
12 intent to rob another or shall together with one or
13 more person or persons rob or assault with intent to
14 rob or shall rob any person and at the same time or
15 immediately before or immediately after such robbery beat
16 strike or ill-use any person or do violence to such per-
17 son the person so offending shall be guilty of felony
18 and being thereof convicted shall be sentenced to pay a
19 fine not exceeding five thousand dollars and undergo an
20 imprisonment by separate or solitary confinement at labor
21 for any term of not less than twenty years
