**AN ACT**

To amend chapter six article one of an act approved the fourteenth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws eight hundred and forty) entitled "An act concerning townships and revising amending and consolidating the law relating thereto" authorizing a State Association of Township Supervisors and providing for the payment of the expenses thereof by the respective counties

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *chapter six article one of an act approved the fourteenth*  
5 *day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen*  
6 *(Pamphlet Laws eight hundred and forty) entitled "An*  
7 *act concerning townships and revising amending and con-*  
8 *solidating the law relating thereto" is hereby amended by*  
9 *adding thereto the following sections*

1 Section 199 That the formation of a State Association  
2 of Township Supervisors of townships of the second class  
3 is hereby authorized The association shall hold annual  
4 meetings at such time and place within the Commonwealth  
5 as it may designate for the purpose of discussing various  
6 questions and subjects pertaining to the duties of town-  
7 ship supervisors and for the purpose of devising uniform  
8 economical and efficient methods of administering the affairs  
9 of townships

10 Section 200 Each county association of township super-  
11 visors and commissioners shall send one township super-  
12 visor for each ten townships of the second class or  
13 fraction thereof within said county as a delegate to each  
14 annual meeting of said State association

15 Section 201 The expenses of the delegates attending  
16 the annual meeting shall not exceed three dollars per day  
17 for each delegate for not more than three days together  
18 with the actual mileage and shall be paid by the re-  
19 spective county associations

20 Section 202 The expenses of the annual meeting in-  
21 cluding expenses of committees printing and stenographers shall  
22 be paid pro rata by the respective county associations and  
23 shall not exceed ten dollars for each county association

24 Section 203 Within thirty days after each annual meet-  
25 ing of the State association the treasurer of the re-  
26 spective county association shall file with the county treas-  
27 urer an itemized statement under oath setting forth where  
28 and when the annual meeting of the State association was  
29 held the number of delegates from the respective associ-

1 ation in attendance and the expenditures due from the  
2 county association for such annual meeting

3 Section 204 The county treasurer shall pay to the  
4 treasurer of the respective county association out of the  
5 county funds the amount expended by the county associ-  
6 ation under the provisions of this act
