AN ACT

To amend sections one thousand one hundred and twenty-one and one thousand one hundred and thirty of an act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one thousand one hundred and twenty-one of an
5 act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand

1 nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred
2 and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school
3 system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with
4 the provisions by which it shall be administered and pre-
5 scribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue
6 to establish and maintain the same and the method of
7 collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general spe-
8 cial or local or any parts thereof that are or may be
9 inconsistent therewith" which reads as follows

10 "Section 1121 The annual salary of each county super-
11 intendent elected or appointed under the provisions of this
12 act shall be paid by the State from appropriations made
13 for this purpose or from the appropriations for the pub-
14 lic schools and shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each
15 of the first one hundred schools within his jurisdiction at
16 the time of his election and five dollars (\$5.00) for each
17 such additional school Provided That the salary of a
18 county superintendent shall not be less than fifteen hun-
19 dred dollars (\$1,500.00) per annum or more than two
20 thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) per annum but a convention
21 of school directors assembled for the purpose of electing
22 a county superintendent may vote him a salary greater
23 than the amount he would receive by this act such in-
24 crease to be paid in all cases out of the school fund
25 apportioned to the school districts over which such county
26 superintendent has supervision before the same is distri-
27 buted The salaries of county superintendents shall be paid
28 quarterly Provided That the provisions of this act relat-
29 ing to the amount and the manner of determining the

1 salaries of county superintendents shall not take effect be-
2 fore the first Monday of June one thousand nine hun-
3 dred and fourteen (1914)" is hereby amended to read as
4 follows

5 Section 1121 The annual salary of each county super-
6 intendent elected or appointed under the provisions of this
7 act shall be paid by the State from appropriations made
8 for this purpose or from the appropriations for the pub-
9 lic schools and shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each
10 of the first one hundred schools within his jurisdiction
11 at the time of his election and five dollars (\$5.00) for
12 each such additional school Provided That the salary of
13 a county superintendent shall not be less than fifteen
14 hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per annum or more than two
15 thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) per annum but a convention
16 of school directors assembled for the purpose of electing
17 a county superintendent may vote him, a salary greater
18 than the amount he would receive by this act such in-
19 crease to be paid in all cases out of the school fund
20 apportioned to the school districts over which such county
21 superintendent has supervision before the same is distributed
22 The salaries of county superintendents shall be paid quar-
23 terly Provided That the provisions of this act relating
24 to the amount and the manner of determining the salaries
25 of county superintendents shall not take effect before the
26 first Monday of June one thousand nine hundred and
27 fourteen (1914)

28 In addition to the said salary each county super-
29 intendent shall receive annually the sum of five hundred

1 dollars to be paid by the State as above provided for
2 use as traveling expenses Such additional sum shall be
3 payable annually in ten monthly installments beginning with
4 the first day of September

5 Section 2 That section one thousand one hundred and
6 thirty of said act which reads as follows

7 "Section 1130 The minimum salary of each assistant
8 county superintendent shall be twelve hundred dollars
9 (\$1,200.00) per year which shall be paid out of the
10 State appropriation for public schools in such payments
11 and manner as the county superintendents are paid The
12 salaries of additional assistant county superintendents whose
13 appointments may be authorized as herein provided shall
14 be fixed by the convention of school directors which pro-
15 vides for their appointment and together with any addi-
16 tional salary granted by said convention to any required
17 assistant county superintendent shall be paid from the
18 school appropriation apportioned among the several school
19 districts under the supervision of the county superintend-
20 ent before the same is distributed The salaries of as-
21 sistant county superintendent shall be paid quarterly" is
22 hereby amended to read as follows

23 Section 1130 The minimum salary of each assistant
24 county superintendent shall be twelve hundred dollars
25 (\$1,200.00) per year which shall be paid out of the
26 State appropriation for public schools in such payments
27 and manner as the county superintendents are paid The
28 salaries of additional assistant county superintendents whose
29 appointments may be authorized as herein provided shall

1 be fixed by the convention of school directors which pro-
2 vides for their appointment and together with any ad-
3 ditional salary granted by said convention to any re-
4 quired assistant county superintendent shall be paid from
5 the school appropriation apportioned among the several
6 school districts under the supervision of the county super-
7 intendent before the same is distributed The salaries of
8 assistant county superintendents shall be paid quarterly

9 In addition to the said salary each assistant county
10 superintendent shall receive annually the sum of five hun-
11 dred dollars to be paid by the State as above provided
12 for use as traveling expenses Such additional sum shall
13 be payable annually in ten monthly installments beginning
14 with the first day of September
