**AN ACT**

Providing that the county treasurers of all counties whose population does not exceed one hundred and fifty thousand shall be paid a salary and fixing the same which shall be in lieu of all commissions and fees and in full compensation of their services

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *from and after the passage of this act the county treas-*  
5 *urers in all counties of this Commonwealth whose popula-*  
6 *tion does not exceed one hundred and fifty thousand shall*  
7 *be paid a salary by said counties which salary shall be*  
8 *in lieu of all fees and commissions heretofore received*  
9 *from county or State or from any other source*

10 Section 2 The salary of the county treasurer in coun-  
11 ties whose population does not exceed twenty thousand in-  
12 habitants shall be one thousand two hundred dollars per  
13 year the salary of the county treasurer in counties whose

1 population is more than twenty thousand and does not  
2 exceed thirty-five thousand inhabitants shall be fifteen hun-  
3 dred dollars per year the salary of the county treasurer  
4 in counties whose population is more than thirty-five thou-  
5 sand and does not exceed fifty thousand inhabitants shall  
6 be two thousand two hundred fifty dollars per year the  
7 salary of the county treasurer in counties whose popula-  
8 tion is more than fifty thousand and does not exceed  
9 seventy-five thousand inhabitants shall be three thousand  
10 dollars per year the salary of the county treasurer in  
11 counties whose population is more than seventy-five thou-  
12 sand and does not exceed one hundred thousand inhabi-  
13 tants shall be three thousand two hundred and fifty dol-  
14 lars per year the salary of the county treasurer in coun-  
15 ties whose population is more than one hundred thousand  
16 and does not exceed one hundred and twenty-five thousand  
17 inhabitants shall be three thousand five hundred dollars  
18 per year the salary of the county treasurer in counties  
19 whose population is more than one hundred and twenty-  
20 five thousand and does not exceed one hundred and fifty  
21 thousand inhabitants shall be four thousand dollars per  
22 year The latest United States census reports shall be  
23 taken as a basis of fixing population

24 Section 3 The salary of the county treasurer in coun-  
25 ties whose population does not exceed one hundred and  
26 fifty thousand shall be paid in monthly installments out  
27 of the moneys in the treasury of the county by the  
28 county treasurer upon warrants drawn by the county commission-  
29 ers Provided however That all office supplies and clerical

1 assistance shall be furnished by the county commissioners  
2 of the proper county and paid for monthly by orders  
3 drawn on county treasurer as other expenses are paid

4 Section 4 The said salaries as specified and provided  
5 in section two of this act shall be in full compensa-  
6 tion for all services rendered either to the county the  
7 State or to any individual firm co-partnership corporation  
8 municipal corporation or quasi-municipal corporation by the  
9 county treasurer in the discharge of his duties or any  
10 duties pertaining to the said office All fees heretofore  
11 fixed by law to be paid to county treasurers for ser-  
12 vices rendered by them shall be collected as heretofore  
13 and by the treasurer paid into the county treasury (ex-  
14 cept where required to be paid to the State) for the  
15 use of the proper county

16 Section 5 Nothing contained in this act shall be con-  
17 strued as affecting the compensation of the present in-  
18 cumbents of the said office of county treasurer in the  
19 various counties affected hereby for the terms for which  
20 they have already been elected

21 Section 6 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-  
22 with whether general special or local be and the same  
23 are hereby repealed
