AN ACT

To amend an act approved the seventh day of July one thousand nine hundred and thirteen (Pamphlet Laws six hundred and seventy-two) entitled "An act relating to and regulating motor vehicles and vehicles trailing after or propelled by motor vehicles controlling their speed upon the public streets and highways in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania providing for their registration and licensing of certain operators by the State Highway Department prohibiting the operation of any motor vehicle by any person when intoxicated or without the consent of the owner forbidding the passage of any law laying a tax upon or requiring the registration of motor vehicles or licensing of any operator or regulating the speed of motor vehicles by any county borough city incorporated town or township establishing the rights of motor vehicles upon the public highways with re-

lation to other vehicles providing for their equipment and for the width of tires to be used upon motor vehicles and vehicles trailing after or propelled by motor vehicles regulating the service of process and proceedings in actions for damages arising therefrom providing for arrest and for service of process and proceedings for violation of this act prescribing the penalties therefor and providing for the disposition of fees collected and fines imposed thereunder" providing for the return of one-half of the license fees from registration to the several cities boroughs and counties to be used for highway purposes

10 Pennsylvania providing for their registration and licensing
11 of certain operators by the State Highway Department pro-
12 hibiting the operation of any motor vehicle by any per-
13 son when intoxicated or without the consent of the
14 owner forbidding the passage of any law laying a tax
15 upon or requiring the registration of motor vehicles or
16 licensing of any operator or regulating the speed of
17 motor vehicles by any county borough city incorporated

1 town or township establishing the rights of motor ve-
2 hicles upon the public highways with relation to other
3 vehicles providing for their equipment and for the width
4 of tires to be used upon motor vehicles and vehicles
5 trailing after or propelled by motor vehicles regulating
6 the service of process and proceedings in actions for
7 damages arising therefrom providing for arrest and for
8 service of process and proceedings for violation of this
9 act prescribing the penalties therefor and providing for
10 the disposition of fees collected and fines imposed there-
11 under" which reads as follows

12 "Section 10 The moneys derived from registrations and
13 from license fees under the provisions of this act shall
14 be paid by the State Highway Department into the
15 State Treasury for safe-keeping and shall by the State
16 Treasurer be placed in a separate fund to be available
17 for the use of the State Highway Department upon req-
18 uisition of the State Highway Commissioner All such
19 moneys hereafter paid into the State Treasury are hereby
20 specifically appropriated to the State Highway Department
21 for the purpose of assisting in the construction mainte-
22 nance improvement and repair of State Highways and
23 State-aid Highways as described in the act creating the
24 State Highway Department approved the thirty-first day of
25 May Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred and eleven
26 The Auditor General shall upon requisition from time to
27 time of the State Highway Commissioner draw his war-
28 rant upon the State Treasurer for the amount specified
29 in such requisition not exceeding however the amount in

1 such fund at the time of making such requisition" is
2 hereby amended to read as follows

3 Section 10 The moneys derived from registrations and
4 from license fees under the provisions of this act shall
5 be paid by the State Highway Department into the State
6 Treasury for safe-keeping and one-half of such money
7 shall by the State Treasurer be placed in a separate
8 fund to be available for the use of the State Highway
9 Department upon requisition of the State Highway Com-
10 missioner The said one-half of such moneys hereafter paid
11 into the State Treasury are hereby specifically appropriated
12 to the State Highway Department for the purpose of as-
13 sisting in the construction maintenance improvement and
14 repair of State Highways and State-aid Highways as de-
15 scribed in the act creating the State Highway Depart-
16 ment approved the thirty-first day of May one thousand
17 nine hundred and eleven The Auditor General shall upon
18 requisition from time to time of the State Highway
19 Commissioner draw his warrant upon the State Treasurer
20 for the amount specified in such requisition not exceeding
21 however the amount in such fund at the time of
22 making such requisition The remaining one-half of the
23 moneys shall by the State Treasurer be placed in a
24 separate fund to be available for the use of the sev-
25 eral cities or boroughs or counties The said one-half of
26 such moneys hereafter paid into the State Treasury are
27 hereby specifically appropriated for the use of the cities
28 or boroughs from which the said motor vehicles were
29 registered or if said motor vehicles were not registered

1 from a city or borough then for the use of the county
2 commissioners of the county from which such application
3 was made and said money shall be held by the respect-
4 ive municipalities or counties and used solely for the
5 purpose of constructing maintaining and improving the
6 streets avenues and highways within the respective muni-
7 cipalities or counties
