## AN ACT

Making an appropriation for providing erecting completing  
maintaining and repairing armories for the use of  
the Pennsylvania National Guard including compensa-  
tion insurance of employes of armories clerical and  
other expenses of the State Armory Board

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That  
4 the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars  
5 (1,200,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary be  
6 and the same is hereby appropriated for the use of the  
7 Armory Board of the State of Pennsylvania for the pur-  
8 pose of providing erecting and completing armories for the  
9 use of the Pennsylvania National Guard the providing  
10 erecting and completing of such armories to be under the  
11 control and direction of the Armory Board of the State

1 of Pennsylvania Provided That the maximum amount to  
2 be expended from this appropriation for the providing erect-  
3 ing or completion of an armory for a company of in-  
4 fantry or field hospital or ambulance company shall be  
5 seventy-five thousand dollars for the providing erection or  
6 completion of an armory for a battery of artillery troop  
7 of cavalry signal corps company or company of engineers  
8 one hundred thousand dollars which sum in each case  
9 shall include where necessary the purchase of suitable  
10 ground and which shall be exclusive of any gift or do-  
11 nation in cash made to or for the benefit of any par-  
12 ticular armory Provided That a machine gun company or  
13 machine gun troop or headquarters company or headquarters  
14 troop or supply company of supply troop shall be pro-  
15 vided for on the basis of a company of infantry And  
16 provided further That armory sites shall be acceptable in  
17 every way as to location and soil tests for building pur-  
18 poses and the title thereof to be insured by the Armory  
19 Board of the State of Pennsylvania in a duly incor-  
20 porated title insurance company and the deed to the Com-  
21 monwealth to be approved by the Attorney General

22 Section 2 The sum of two hundred and ninety thou-  
23 sand dollars (\$290,000) or so much thereof as may be  
24 necessary is hereby specifically appropriated for the purpose  
25 of maintaining and caring for armories heretofore erected  
26 or provided and to be erected or provided for the two  
27 fiscal years beginning June first nineteen hundred and nine-  
28 teen and to include necessary repairs and expenses in  
29 maintenance of armories compensation insurance of caretakers

1 janitors and other employes in and about said armories  
2 premium on fire insurance and title insurance advertise-  
3 ments for bids actual traveling expenses of members of  
4 the Armory Board of the State of Pennsylvania clerical  
5 general and contingent expenses of the board and expenses  
6 of inspection of armories
