## AN ACT

To amend section one of an act approved the eighth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirteen (Pamphlet Laws one hundred and fifty-seven) entitled "An act regulating the appointment confirmation duties salary and expenses of county detectives in counties containing not less than three hundred thousand nor more than seven hundred thousand inhabitants"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 section one of an act approved the eighth day of May  
5 one thousand nine hundred and thirteen (Pamphlet Laws  
6 one hundred and fifty-seven) entitled "An act regulating  
7 the appointment confirmation duties salary and expenses of  
8 county detectives in counties containing not less than three  
9 hundred thousand nor more than seven hundred thousand  
10 inhabitants" which as amended by an act approved the  
11 twenty-ninth day of April one thousand nine hundred and

1 fifteen (Pamphlet Laws two hundred and two) entitled  
2 "An act to amend an act approved the eighth day of  
3 May one thousand nine hundred and thirteen entitled 'An  
4 act regulating the appointment confirmation duties salary  
5 and expenses of county detectives in counties containing not less  
6 than three hundred thousand nor more than seven hundred  
7 thousand inhabitants' by extending its provisions to counties  
8 having a population of two hundred fifty thousand inhabi-  
9 tants but not more than seven hundred thousand inhabi-  
10 tants and by repealing section three of the act" reads as  
11 follows

12 "Section 1 In counties containing not less than two  
13 hundred fifty thousand nor more than seven hundred thou-  
14 sand inhabitants the district attorney of the proper county  
15 shall have the power to appoint certain police officers to  
16 be designated 'county detectives' not exceeding four in num-  
17 ber as he shall consider necessary at an annual salary  
18 of eighteen hundred dollars (\$1,800) in addition to such  
19 expenses as are hereinafter provided for which salary and ex-  
20 penses shall be paid monthly from the funds of the  
21 proper county " is hereby further amended to read as  
22 follows.

23 Section 1 In counties containing not less than two  
24 hundred fifty thousand nor more than seven hundred thou-  
25 sand inhabitants the district attorney of the proper county  
26 shall have the power to appoint certain police officers to  
27 be designated "county detectives" not exceeding four in  
28 number as he shall consider necessary one of which shall  
29 be designated as chief county detective at an annual sal-

1 ary of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) and the other  
2 as county detectives at an annual salary of twenty-two  
3 hundred dollars (\$2,200.00) in addition to such expenses as  
4 are hereinafter\* provided for which salary and expenses  
5 shall be paid monthly from the funds of the proper  
6 county
