AN ACT

Relating to the employment of Deputy Wardens Guards
Turnkeys and Matrons and other employes in jails of
this Commonwealth and regulating the number of work
days and hours

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 from and after the passage of this act no Deputy
5 Wardens Guards Turnkeys Matrons or other employes of
6 any county jail of this Commonwealth shall work more
7 than six days per week and not more than eight hours
8 on any such work days
