AN ACT

To establish as a State Highway a certain section of
public road in the county of Lancaster

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 a certain section of public road commencing at a point
5 in the boundary line of the city of Lancaster and run-
6 ning by way of the intersection of the Lancaster and
7 Lititz turnpike and the Lancaster and Ephrata turnpike in
8 Manheim township in the county of Lancaster through
9 Roseville Landis Valley and Oregon to a junction with
10 the State Highway Route One Hundred Forty-eight thence
11 over said State Highway Route One Hundred Forty-eight
12 to the boundary line of the city of Reading in the
13 county of Berks shall be adopted by the Commonwealth
14 as a State Highway and shall be constructed improved

1 and maintained at the sole expense of the Commonwealth
2 under the provisions of existing laws governing State
3 Highways

4 Section 2 The cost and expense of the construction
5 improvement and maintenance of the highway herein de-
6 scribed shall be paid out of any moneys appropriated to
7 the State Highway Department for maintenance construction
8 and improvement of State Highways
