AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the trustees of the University
of Pennsylvania

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 the sum of two million four hundred thousand dollars
5 (\$2,400,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary be
6 and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to the
7 trustees of the University of Pennsylvania for the two
8 fiscal years beginning June first one thousand nine hun-
9 dred and nineteen for the following purposes namely
10 For the general maintenance of the University and the
purchase of such apparatus and equipment as the trustees
12 may deem necessary for the best interests of the Uni-
13 versity of Pennsylvania the sum of one million eight hun-
14 dred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary

1 For the increase of the University Library including
2 the purchase of books required for the special preparation
3 of teachers for their professional work for graduate in-
4 struction and original investigation the sum of fifty thou-
5 sand dollars (\$50,000) or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary

7 For the maintenance of the School of Education of
8 the University of Pennsylvania the sum of one hundred
9 thousand dollars (\$100,000) or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary

11 For the maintenance of the Extension Schools of the
12 University of Pennsylvania the sum of one hundred thou-
13 sand dollars (\$100,000) or so much thereof as may be
14 necessary

15 For the maintenance at the University of a summer
16 session for teachers the sum of fifty thousand dollars
17 (\$50,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary

18 For the erection of an administrative and executive
19 building to be known as State Hall the sum of three
20 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary
