AN ACT

Relating to appointments under the civil service in counties cities and boroughs and providing penalties

1 Section 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That
4 the names of all persons who shall attain the average
5 per centage required by law or the rules and regulations
6 of the board or commission having in charge the civil
7 service examinations in any county city or borough shall
8 be placed on the eligible list for appointments under the
9 civil service in such counties cities and boroughs

10 Section 2 The board or commission shall arrange the
11 names of the persons on any eligible list according to
12 their percentage and shall certify to the appointing power
13 upon request the four names standing highest on said
14 list and the appointing power shall appoint any one of
15 such four persons in like manner as other appointments

1 are made except as hereinafter provided in the case of
2 honorably discharged soldiers sailors and marines

3 Section 3 Preference may be given by the appointing
4 power to all honorably discharged soldiers sailors and
5 marines who served in the army or navy of the United
6 States during times of war who have passed the re-
7 quired civil service examinations notwithstanding the fact
8 that the names of such soldiers sailors and marines may
9 not be among the four names standing highest upon the
10 eligible lists as hereinbefore provided Such appointments of
11 soldiers sailors and marines may be made without regard
12 to any age limitations now provided for by law or the
13 rules and regulations of any board or commission having
14 in charge civil service regulations in any county city or
15 borough

16 Section 4 Any person violating the provisions of this
17 act shall be summarily removed from office and shall be
18 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall
19 be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred
20 dollars or undergo an imprisonment not exceeding six
21 months or both in the discretion of the court
