AN ACT

To amend section fourteen of an act approved the seventh day of June one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws five hundred and seventy-two) entitled "An act to provide for the protection and preservation of game game-quadrupeds and game-birds and song and insectivorous and other wild birds and prescribing penalties for violation of its several provisions"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 so much of section fourteen of an act approved the
5 seventh day of June one thousand nine hundred and
6 seventeen (Pamphlet Laws five hundred and seventy-two) en-
7 titled "An act to provide for the protection and
8 preservation of game game-quadrupeds and game-birds and

1 song and insectivorous and other wild birds and prescrib-
2 ing penalties for violation of its several provisions" which
3 reads as follows

4 "For the ruffed-grouse commonly called pheasant Vir-
5 ginia partridge commonly called quail wood-cock ring-necked
6 pheasants Hungarian quail the red gray black and fox
7 squirrel from the twentieth day of October to the thir-
8 tieth day of November For the wild turkey from the
9 fifteenth day of November to the thirtieth day of No-
10 vember For the wild rabbit and the hare from the first
11 day of November to the fifteenth day of December For
12 the raccoon from the first day of September to the
13 thirty-first day of December For bear from the fifteenth
14 day of October to the fifteenth day of December For
15 male deer with antlers extending not less than two
16 inches above the hair from the first day of December
17 to the fifteenth day of the same month For upland or
18 grass plover from the first day of August to the thir-
19 tieth day of November For the rail coot or mud-hen
20 reed bird sandpiper tattler curlew Wilson or jack snipe
21 the birds commonly called blackbirds or any other shore
22 bird excepting woodcock from the first day of September to
23 the thirtieth day of November For all kinds of birds
24 known as wild water-fowl from the fifteenth day of
25 September to the thirty-first day of January next fol-
26 lowing" is hereby amended to read as follows

27 For the ruffed-grouse commonly called pheasant Vir-
28 ginia partridge commonly called quail woodcock ring-necked
29 pheasants Hungarian quail the red gray black and fox

1 squirrel from the twentieth day of October to the thir-
2 tieth day of November For the wild-turkey from the
3 fifteenth day of November to the thirtieth day of No-
4 vember For the wild rabbit and the hare from the first
5 day of November to the fifteenth day of December For
6 the raccoon from the first day of September to the
7 thirty-first day of December For bear from the fifteenth
8 day of October to the fifteenth day of December For
9 male deer with antlers extending not less than two
10 inches above the hair from the fifteenth day of Novem-
11 ber to the thirtieth day of the same month For upland
12 or grass plover from the first day of August to the
13 thirtieth day of November For the rail coot or mud-hen
14 reed-bird sandpiper tattler curlew Wilson or jack-snipe the
15 birds commonly called blackbirds or any other shore birds
16 excepting woodcock from the first day of September to
17 the thirtieth day of November For all kinds of birds
18 known as wild water-fowl from the fifteenth day of
19 September to the thirty-first day of January next fol-
20 lowing
