AN ACT

To amend sections one and two of an act approved the twenty-fifth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws one thousand one hundred and ninety-five) entitled "An act for the encouragement of agriculture and the holding of agricultural exhibitions providing State aid for certain agricultural associations and regulating the payment thereof"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one of an act approved the twenty-fifth day of
5 July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet
6 Laws one thousand one hundred and ninety-five) entitled
7 "An act for the encouragement of agriculture and the
8 holding of agricultural exhibitions providing State aid for
9 certain agricultural associations and regulating the payment
10 thereof" which reads as follows

1 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
2 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
3 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
4 authority of the same That for the purpose of encourag-
5 ing agriculture and the holding of agricultural exhibitions
6 of farm products an incorporated agricultural association
7 conforming to the requirements of this act is entitled to
8 receive from the Commonwealth an annual sum not ex-
9 ceeding one thousand dollars equal to the amount paid
10 by such association as premiums for exhibits at its annual
11 exhibition exclusive of premiums paid on trials of speed
12 Such premiums shall be paid only upon products of this
13 Commonwealth" is hereby amended to read as follows

14 Sectin 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and Houe of
15 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
16 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by author-
17 ity of the same That for the purpose of encouraging
18 agriculture and the holding of agricultural exhibitions of
19 farm products an incorporated agricultural association con-
20 forming to the requirements of this act is entitled to
21 receive from the Commonwealth an annual sum not ex-
22 ceeding two thousand dollars equal to the amount paid
23 by such association as premiums for exhibits at its an-
24 nual exhibition exclusive of premiums paid on trials of
25 speed Such premiums shall be paid only upon products
26 of this Commonwealth

27 Section 2 That section two of said act which reads
28 as follows

1 "Section 2 In case there is more than one associa-
2 tion holding such annual exhibitions in a county such as-
3 sociations shall be entitled to receive from the Common-
4 wealth a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the sum
5 of two thousand dollars to be apportioned by the Auditor
6 General among such associations according to the amount
7 of premiums paid for the exhibits at the last exhibi-
8 tion of each of such associations exclusive of premiums
9 for trials of speed.

10 No association shall receive from the Commonwealth a
11 greater sum than that paid by the association as pre-
12 miums on exhibits exclusive of premiums paid for trials
13 of speed" is hereby amended to read as follows

14 Section 2 In case there is more than one association
15 holding such annual exhibitions in a county such associa-
16 tions shall be entitled to receive from the Commonwealth
17 a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of four
18 thousand dollars to be apportioned by the Auditor General
19 among such associations according to the amount of pre-
20 miums paid for the exhibits at the last exhibition of
21 each of such associations exclusive of premiums for trials
22 of speed

23 No association shall receive from the Commonwealth a
24 greater sum than that paid by the association as pre-
25 miums on exhibits exclusive of premiums paid for trials
26 of speed
