AN ACT

Making it compulsory on hotels restaurants and lunch-rooms where food is displayed on a counter or counters to display such food only under a glass covering and fixing a penalty

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *after the passage of this act it shall be obligatory on*
5 *all hotels restaurants and lunch-rooms when food is to*
6 *be displayed on a counter or counters it shall be so*
7 *displayed only under a glass covering*

8 Section 2 That a violation of this act shall be a
9 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-
10 five (\$25.00) dollars for each offense to be imposed on
11 the owner or manager
