## AN ACT

Providing that where wall-papering in buildings is to be done the old paper shall be removed from the walls and fixing a penalty

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 after the passage of this act it shall be illegal for  
5 the owners of stores and dwelling houses or other build-  
6 ings where persons live or congregate to permit new  
7 wall-paper to be placed on the walls of such buildings  
8 without having the old or former coating or coatings of  
9 paper removed from the walls that are to be re-papered

10 Section 2 Where an occupier or lessee of a building  
11 shall do or contract to have wall-papering done the re-  
12 sponsibility to comply with the regulation of this act  
13 shall rest on such occupier or lessee

1 Section 3 Violation of this act shall be punishable by  
2 a fine of not to exceed fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each  
3 offense
