AN ACT

Providing for the appointment of tipstaves in the Common Pleas Courts and in the Courts of Quarter Sessions and Oyer and Terminer in counties containing more than one million five hundred thousand inhabitants

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *hereafter in counties having a population of more than*
5 *one million five hundred thousand inhabitants the tipstaves*
6 *of the Courts of Quarter Sessions and of the Courts*
7 *of Oyer and Terminer and general jail delivery shall be*
8 *appointed by the clerk of said courts and the tipstaves*
9 *of the Courts of Common Pleas of such counties shall*
10 *be appointed by the prothonotaries of such counties Such*
11 *tipstaves shall receive the same compensation as now pro-*
12 *vided by law*

13 Section 2 All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
14 with are hereby repealed
