AN ACT

Fixing the maximum amount of commissions and fees to be retained by county treasurers in certain counties as compensation for services and requiring all commissions and fees in excess thereof to be paid into the county treasury for the use of the county

1 Section . 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *in all counties having a population of more than twenty*
5 *thousand and less than fifty thousand inhabitants the com-*
6 *missions and fees paid to any county treasurer under any*
7 *law whatsoever as compensation for his services as such*
8 *county treasurer shall in no case exceed the sum of*
9 *four thousand five hundred dollars per annum All moneys*
10 *received by the county treasurer in any county as com-*
11 *missions and fees from whatever source in excess of the*
12 *maximum herein prescribed shall be paid into the county*
13 *treasury for the use of the county The population of*

1 any county coming within the provisions of this act shall
2 be ascertained at any time by reference to the last pre-
3 ceding decennial census of the United States

4 Section 2 All acts and parts of acts general local and
5 special inconsistent with the provisions of this act are
6 hereby repealed
