AN ACT

To amend section three hundred and three of an act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *section three hundred and three of an act approved the*
5 *eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and*
6 *eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred and nine) entitled*

8 ent therewith" which reads as follows

9 "Section 303 A permanent organization shall then be
10 effected for the ensuing year as follows

11 In all school districts of the first class the school
12 directors shall elect a president and a vice-president from
13 their members and a secretary who is not a member
14 They shall elect the treasurer of the city constituting
15 such school district of the first class as the school
16 treasurer for such school district for the ensuing fiscal
17 year In each school district of the second third or
18 fourth class the school directors shall elect from their
19 members a president and a vice-president and shall an-
20 nually on the first Monday of July elect a secretary
21 and a treasurer each of whom shall serve for one year
22 In school districts of the second class the secretary and
23 treasurer shall not be members of the board In dis-
24 tricts of the third and fourth class they may be mem-
25 bers of the board The same person shall not be secre-
26 tary and treasurer of any board of school directors" is
27 hereby amended to read as follows

28 Section 303 A permanent organization shall then be
29 effected for the ensuing year as follows

1 In all school districts of the first class the school
2 directors shall elect a president and a vice-president from
3 their members and a secretary who is not a member
4 They shall elect the treasurer of the city constituting
5 such school district of the first class as the school
6 treasurer for such school district for the ensuing fiscal
7 year In each school district of the second and third
8 class the school directors shall elect from their members
9 a president and a vice-president and shall annually on
10 the first Monday of July elect a treasurer each to
11 serve for one year and shall on the first Monday of
12 July one thousand nine hundred and nineteen and every
13 four years thereafter elect a secretary for a term of
14 four years Vacancies in the office of secretary shall be
15 filled for the unexpired term In each school district of
16 the fourth class the school directors shall elect from
17 their members a president and a vice-president and shall
18 annually on the first Monday of July elect a treasurer
19 each of whom shall serve for a term of one year
20 They shall also on the first Monday of July one thou-
21 sand nine hundred and nineteen elect a secretary for
22 any term not exceeding four years and shall elect suc-
23 cessors to such secretary at the expiration of the term
24 of such secretary for terms not exceeding four years
25 Vacancies in the office of such secretary shall be filled
26 for the unexpired term In school districts of the second
27 class the secretary and treasurer shall not be members
28 of the board In districts of the third and fourth class

1 they may be members of the board The same person
2 shall not be secretary and treasurer of any board of
3 school directors
