A SUPPLEMENT

To an act approved the second day of May one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine (Pamphlet Laws one hundred eighty-four) entitled "An act to provide revenue by imposing a mercantile license tax on venders of or dealers in goods wares and merchandise and providing for the collection of said tax" provided for the appointment of and the fixing of salaries of mercantile appraisers in certain counties and providing for the disposition of moneys collected as fees for mercantile appraisers

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That
4 in all counties having a population of more than one
5 million and less than one million five hundred thousand
6 inhabitants the Auditor General shall appoint five citizens
7 as mercantile appraisers who shall each receive a salary
8 not to exceed the sum of five thousand dollars per

1 annum which salary shall be fixed by the Auditor
2 General. The fee of fifty cents as now provided and
3 collected by law from the dealer and paid to the mer-
4 cantile appraiser shall be collected and paid into the
5 county treasury for the use of the Commonwealth. In
6 lieu of the fee of fifty cents heretofore paid to the
7 mercantile appraiser the salary of such appraisers shall
8 be paid monthly out of the mercantile license moneys
9 collected upon bills rendered to and approved by the
10 Auditor General.

11 This act shall take effect the first day of October
12 one thousand nine hundred nineteen.

13 Section 2 All acts and parts of acts general spe-
14 cial and local inconsistent with the provisions of this act
15 are hereby repealed.
