AN ACT

Declaring certain gas engines operated without mufflers
nuisances and prescribing penalties

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *it shall be unlawful to operate any stationary engine*
5 *the motive power of which is created by the internal*
6 *combustion of gas unless such engine is equipped with*
7 *a muffler so as to prevent any loud annoying or dis-*
8 *turbing noises and any operation of such stationary engine*
9 *in violation of this section is hereby declared to be a*
10 *nuisance and may in addition to the penalty provided*
11 *for in section two be abated as such*

12 Section 2 Any person co-partnership association or cor-
13 poration who or which after written notice to discontinue
14 or abate any such nuisance shall fail or neglect to do
15 so upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding be-
16 fore any magistrate alderman or justice of the peace of

1 the county shall be sentenced to pay a fine not ex-
2 ceeding one hundred dollars All fines collected under the
3 provisions of this act shall be paid for the use of the
4 school district where the offense is committed
