## AN ACT

To amend section forty-five of an act approved the twenty-eighth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws one thousand two hundred and fifteen) entitled "An act to revise amend and consolidate the law relating to fish and providing penalties"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 section forty-five of an act approved the twenty-eighth day  
5 of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pam-  
6 phlet Laws one thousand two hundred and fifteen) entitled  
7 "An act to revise amend and consolidate the law relat-  
8 ing to fish and providing penalties" which reads as fol-  
9 lows

10 "Section 45 No person shall use any device means  
11 or method whatsoever except as in this article otherwise  
12 provided for taking fish from the waters within this Com-

1 monwealth except the following that is to say for

2 (a) Game-fish a single rod and line or one hand line  
3 with not more than three hooks attached

4 (b) Food-fish rods and lines or one handline with not  
5 more than three hooks attached The rods and lines and  
6 the handline must be under the immediate control of the  
7 person using the same

8 (c) Bait-fish rods hooks and lines with not more than  
9 three hooks attached to each line a dipnet or minnow  
10 seine not over four feet in diameter a minnow-trap with  
11 not more than one opening which shall not exceed one  
12 inch in diameter The rods hooks and lines must be un-  
13 der the immediate control of the person using the same"  
14 is hereby amended to read as follows

15 Section 45 No person shall use any device means or  
16 method whatsoever except as in this article otherwise pro-  
17 vided for taking fish from the waters within this Common-  
18 wealth except the following that is to say for

19 (a) Game-fish a single rod and line or one handline  
20 with not more than three hooks attached

21 (b) Food-fish rods and lines or one handline with not
