AN ACT

To amend section one thousand four hundred and thirty-six of an act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith"

1. Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2. *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3. *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*

10 "Section 1436 Such attendance officers shall be paid
11 such amounts and in such manner as the board
12 of school directors appointing them may decide and
13 they shall at all times perform the duties of
14 their appointment under the direction of the board of
15 school directors appointing them Provided That in districts
16 of the fourth class the compensation of any attendance
17 officer shall not exceed two dollars (\$2.00) per day for
18 each day actually engaged Every school district shall re-
19 port annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction
20 for publication in his report upon the enforcement of the
21 provisions for compulsory attendance and the cost thereof
22 in such detail as said Superintendent of Public Instruc-
23 tion shall request" is hereby amended to read as follows
24 Section 1436 Such attendance officers shall be paid
25 such amounts and in such manner as the board of
26 school directors appointing them may decide and they shall
27 at all times perform the duties of their appointment un-
28 der the direction of the board of school directors appoint-
29 ing them Provided That in districts of the fourth class after

1 the beginning of the school term of one thousand nine
2 hundred and nineteen and one thousand nine hundred and
3 twenty the compensation of any attendance officer shall
4 not exceed four dollars (\$4.00) per day for each day
5 actually engaged. Every school district shall report an-
6 nually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction for pub-
7 lication in his report upon the enforcement of the pro-
8 visions for compulsory attendance and the cost thereof in
9 such detail as said Superintendent of Public Instruction
10 shall request.
