AN ACT

To amend an act approved the twenty-seventh day of April one thousand nine hundred and nine (Pamphlet Laws two hundred and fifty-eight) entitled "An act authorizing the employment of stenographers by the district attorneys of certain counties" as amended

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*

3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one of an act approved the twenty-seventh day
5 of April one thousand nine hundred and nine (Pamphlet
6 Laws two hundred and fifty-eight) entitled "An act au-
7 thorizing the employment of stenographers by the district
8 attorneys of certain counties" which as amended by the
9 act approved the fourth day of June one thousand nine
10 hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws eight hundred and
11 seven) entitled "An act to amend an act entitled 'An

1 act authorizing the employment of stenographers by the
2 district attorneys of certain counties approved the twenty-
3 seventh day of April one thousand nine hundred and
4 nine" reads as follows

5 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
6 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
7 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
8 authority of the same That from and after the passage
9 of this act the district attorney of any county which
10 shall have less than two hundred and fifty thousand in-
11 habitants and more than ninety thousand inhabitants may
12 employ a stenographer as an assistant in his office at a
13 salary not to exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars
14 per year to be paid in the same manner that other
15 county officers are paid" is hereby further amended to
16 read as follows

17 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and house of
18 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
19 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
20 authority of the same That from and after the passage
21 of this act the district attorney of any county which
22 shall have less than two hundred and fifty thousand in-
23 habitants and more than ninety thousand inhabitants may
24 employ a stenographer as an assistant in his office at a
25 salary not to exceed eighteen hundred dollars per year to
26 be paid in the same manner that other county officers
27 are paid
