AN ACT

To amend sections one and two of an act approved the first day of June one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws seven hundred and six) entitled "An act requiring the county commissioners to provide at the expense of the county a telephone typewriter and stenographer for the use of the county superintendent of schools" by requiring the county commissioners to furnish such other equipment as the county superintendent may require

5 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
6 authority of the same That in each county in the Com-
7 monwealth the county superintendent of schools may be
8 provided at the expense of the county with a telephone
9 a typewriter and a stenographer In counties having more
10 than three hundred teachers in the public schools the
11 stenographer may be employed by the year In counties
12 having less than three hundred teachers in the public
13 schools the stenographer may be employed for three days
14 of each week or the equivalent of such time during the
15 year" is hereby amended to read as follows

16 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
17 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
18 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
19 authority of the same That in each county in the Com-
20 monwealth the county superintendent of schools shall be
21 provided at the expense of the county with a telephone
22 a typewriter and a stenographer and such other equipment
23 as said superintendent may require In counties having
24 more than two hundred and fifty teachers in the public
25 schools the stenographer may be employed by the year In
26 counties having less than two hundred and fifty teachers
27 in the public schools the stenographer may be employed
28 for three days of each week or the equivalent of such time
29 during the year.

1 Section 2 That section two of the said act which
2 reads as follows

3 "Section 2 The stenographer may be chosen by the
4 superintendent and the compensation shall be fixed by the
5 superintendent and county commissioners and shall be paid
6 out of the county treasury" is hereby amended to read
7 as follows.

8 Section 2 The stenographer shall be chosen by the
9 superintendent and the compensation shall be fixed by the
10 superintendent and county commissioners and shall be paid
11 out of the county treasury in monthly installments
