AN ACT

Amending the first and second sections of an act entitled "An act to regulate the salaries of tipstaves in the courts of common pleas oyer and terminer and general jail delivery quarter sessions of the peace and orphans' courts in counties having a population of over eight hundred thousand and less than one million four hundred thousand inhabitants" approved the twentieth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen by increasing the minimum and maximum salaries of said tipstaves and making the president judge of the court of common pleas or orphans' court a member of the salary board when such salaries are to be fixed.

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one of an act entitled "An act to regulate the
5 salaries of tipstaves in the courts of common pleas oyer

1 and terminer and general jail delivery quarter sessions of
2 the peace and orphans' courts in counties having a popu-
3 lation of over eight hundred thousand and less than one
4 million four hundred thousand inhabitants" approved the
5 twentieth day of July one thousand nine hundred and
6 seventeen (Pamphlet Laws eleven hundred and thirty-eight)
7 which reads as follows

8 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
9 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
10 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
11 authority of the same That the tipstaves in the courts
12 of common pleas oyer and terminer and general jail de-
13 livery quarter sessions of the peace and orphans' courts
14 in counties having a population of over eight hundred
15 thousand and less than one million four hundred thousand
16 inhabitants shall receive such salary as shall be fixed by
17 the salary board not exceeding the sum of eighteen hun-
18 dred dollars nor less than one thousand dollars per
19 annum The said salary to be paid out of the county
20 treasury monthly" be and the same is hereby amended to
21 read as follows

22 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
23 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
24 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
25 authority of the same That the tipstaves in the courts
26 of common pleas oyer and terminer and general jail de-
27 livery quarter sessions of the peace and orphans' courts in
28 counties having a population of over eight hundred thou-
29 sand and less than one million four hundred thousand in-

1 habitants shall receive such salary as shall be fixed by
2 the salary board not exceeding the sum of twenty-two
3 hundred dollars nor less than fifteen hundred dollars per
4 annum The said salary to be paid out of the county
5 treasury monthly

6 Section 2 That section two of said act which reads
7 as follows

8 "Section 2 The presiding judge of the said court of
9 common pleas shall constitute a member of the salary
10 board when said salaries are to be fixed" be and the
11 same is hereby amended to read as follows

12 Section 2 The president judge of the said court of
13 common pleas shall constitute a member of the salary
14 board when said salaries in the courts of common pleas
15 oyer and terminer and general jail delivery and quarter
16 sessions of the peace are to be fixed The president
17 judge of the said orphans' court shall constitute a mem-
18 ber of the salary board when said salaries in the
19 orphans' court are to be fixed
