**AN ACT**

To amend an act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith"

1      Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *the act approved the eighteenth day of May one thou-*  
5 *sand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred*  
6 *and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school*  
7 *system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with*

1 the provisions by which it shall be administered and pre-  
2 scribing penalties for the violation thereof providing reve-  
3 nue to establish and maintain the same and the method  
4 of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general  
5 special or local or any parts thereof that are or may  
6 be inconsistent therewith" is hereby amended by adding the  
7 following section

8 Section 1205A The salary of any teacher in any of  
9 the school districts of the Commonwealth may be increased  
10 at any time during the year for which such teacher is  
11 employed whenever the board of school directors of the  
12 district deems it necessary or advisable to do so When-  
13 ever such increase is determined upon by the action of  
14 the school board by mutual consent of the parties the  
15 contract existing between them may be cancelled Thereupon  
16 a new contract shall be entered into between the parties  
17 The new contract shall contain no changes from the orig-  
18 inal contract except in the matter of salary unless ex-  
19 pressly agreed upon between the contracting parties

20 Any increases of salary heretofore granted and paid  
21 by any school board during the school year shall be as  
22 valid and binding upon the school district as if made  
23 after the passage of this act notwithstanding that the  
24 original contract was not cancelled or a new contract  
25 entered into
