AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Robert Wood Home of
Philadelphia Pennsylvania

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or so much*
5 *thereof as may be necessary is hereby specifically appro-*
6 *priated to the Robert Wood Home of Philadelphia Penn-*
7 *sylvania for the two fiscal years beginning June first one*
8 *thousand nine hundred nineteen for the following purposes*

9 For the purpose of maintenance the sum of five thou-
10 sand dollars (\$5,000) or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary

12 For new buildings the sum of ten thousand dollars
13 (\$10,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary
