AN ACT

To amend section two thousand six hundred and twenty-four of an act approved the eighteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws three hundred and nine) entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith" as amended,

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *section two thousand six hundred and twenty-four of an*

9 be inconsistent therewith" which as amended by an act
10 approved the twenty-first day of May one thousand nine
11 hundred and thirteen (Pamphlet Laws two hundred and
12 eighty-eight) entitled "A supplement to an act entitled 'An
13 act to establish a public school system in the Common-
14 wealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by
15 which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for
16 the violation thereof providing a revenue to establish and
17 maintain ~~the~~ same and the method of collecting such
18 revenue and repealing all laws general special or local
19 or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent
20 therewith' approved the eighteenth day of May Anno Dom-
21 ini one thousand nine hundred and eleven amending sec-
22 tion two thousand six hundred and twenty-two two thou-
23 sand six hundred and twenty-four two thousand six hun-
24 dred and twenty-six and two thousand six hundred and
25 twenty-seven thereof and also conferring upon taxpayers
26 similar rights in regard to reports of auditors of school
27 districts of the second third and fourth classes filed prior
28 to the passage of this act as are hereby conferred by
29 the above-enumerated amending sections upon taxpayers in

1 regard to such reports of auditors hereafter filed and
2 providing a similar method of disposition of appeals from
3 such reports of auditors filed prior to the passage of
4 this act as is provided hereby in regard to appeals
5 from reports of auditors filed subsequently hereto" which
6 reads as follows

7 "Section 2624 If in any report filed by the auditors
8 of any school district of the second or third class there
9 has been any sum charged against any person or per-
10 sons the amount charged against such person or persons
11 shall in the absence of an appeal within thirty days as
12 aforesaid by such person or persons become a judgment
13 and shall be entered by the prothonotary in favor of
14 the school district against the person or persons charged
15 therewith the same to be collected from such person or
16 persons or the sureties thereof by the school district for
17 its use and benefit or any taxpayer of such district may
18 on its behalf proceed to enforce collection of such judg-
19 ment for said school district by any appropriate proceed-
20 ing execptionary or otherwise upon filing bond with suf-
21 ficient surety or sureties conditioned to indemnify and save
22 harmless said school district from any costs accruing by
23 reason of such proceeding" is hereby amended to read
24 as follows

25 Section 2624 If in any report filed by the auditors
26 of any school district of the second or third class there
27 has been any sum charged or any balance stated therein
28 against any person or persons the amount charged or any
29 balance stated therein against such person or persons shall

1 in the absence of an appeal within thirty days as afore-
2 said by such person or persons become a judgment and
3 shall be entered by the prothonotary in favor of the
4 school district against the person or persons charged there-
5 with the same to be collected from such person or per-
6 sons or the sureties thereof by the school district for
7 its use and benefit or any taxpayer of such district may
8 on its behalf proceed to enforce collection of such judg-
9 ment for said school district by any appropriate proceed-
10 ing executionary or otherwise upon filing bond with suf-
11 ficient surety or sureties conditioned to indemnify and
12 save harmless said school district from any costs accruing
13 by reason of such proceeding
