AN ACT

To establish as a State highway a certain section of public road in the counties of Dauphin and Northumberland

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That*
4 a certain section of public road commencing at a point
5 on State highway route number three hundred and thirty-
6 six at or near the southern boundary of Uniontown bor-
7 ough in the county of Dauphin and running thence to a
8 point on the dividing line between the counties of Dauphin
9 and Northumberland and thence by way of Mandata in
10 Northumberland county to a point on State highway route
11 number one leading from Dalmatia to Herndon shall be
12 adopted by the Commonwealth as a State highway and
13 shall be constructed improved and maintained at the sole
14 expense of the Commonwealth under the provisions of ex-
15 isting laws governing State highways

1 Section 2 The cost and expense of the construction
2 improvement and maintenance of the highway herein de-
3 scribed shall be paid out of any moneys appropriated to
4 the State Highway Department for the construction main-
5 tenance and improvement of State highways
