AN ACT

Authorizing any company incorporated under the laws of any other State for the purpose of cutting harvesting storing transporting and selling natural ice or for any of said purposes to erect and maintain buildings and storage houses and to have and to hold either by leases for terms of years or by deed in fee simple real estate to an amount necessary and proper therefor

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That
4 it shall and may be lawful for any company incorpor-
5 ated under the laws of any other State for the pur-
6 pose of cutting harvesting storing transporting and selling
7 natural ice or for any of such purposes to erect and
8 maintain buildings and store houses and to have and to
9 hold either by leases for terms of years or by deed in

1 fee simple real estate within this Commonwealth to an
2 amount necessary and proper therefor Provided That noth-
3 ing herein contained shall be deemed to prevent or re-
4 lieve real estate taken and held by such company under
5 the provisions of this statute from being taxed in like
6 manner with other real estate within this Commonwealth
7 and further provided that no foreign corporation shall be
8 entitled to employ any greater amount of capital in any
9 such business than the same kind of corporations organ-
10 ized under the laws of this State are entitled to em-
11 ploy and provided further that every such foreign corpor-
12 ation doing business as aforesaid in this Commonwealth
13 shall be liable to taxation to an amount not exceeding
14 that imposed on corporations organized for similar pur-
15 poses under the laws of this State and every such for-
16 eign corporation taking the benefit of this company shall
17 make the same returns to the Auditor General that are
18 now required by law of the corporations of this State

19 Section 2 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with
20 the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby
21 repealed
