**AN ACT**

To amend section one of an act approved the fourth day of April one thousand nine hundred and seven (Pamphlet Laws forty-eight) entitled "An act to fix the salaries of the deputy register clerks and employes in the office of the register of wills of any county of this Commonwealth having a population of one million or over" as amended

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 section one of an act approved the fourth day of April  
5 one thousand nine hundred and seven (Pamphlet Laws  
6 forty-eight) entitled "An act to fix the salaries of the  
7 deputy register clerks and employes in the office of the  
8 register of wills of any county of this Commonwealth  
9 having a population of one million or over" which as

1 amended by an act approved the fifth day of April one  
2 thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws one  
3 hundred eighty-three) entitled "An act to amend the first  
4 section of an act approved the fourth day of April  
5 Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred and seven en-  
6 titled 'An act to fix the salaries of the deputy reg-  
7 ister clerks and employes in the office of the register  
8 of wills of any county of this Commonwealth having a  
9 population of one million or over' so as to make it  
10 apply to counties containing a population of one million  
11 four hundred thousand or over" reads as follows

12 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House  
13 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in  
14 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the  
15 authority of the same That the salaries or compensation  
16 of the deputy register clerks and employes in the office  
17 of the register of wills of any county of this Common-  
18 wealth having a population of one million four hundred  
19 thousand or over as computed by the last preceding  
20 United States census shall be as follows Deputy register  
21 at the rate of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum  
22 one chief clerk seventeen hundred dollars one assistant  
23 chief clerk sixteen hundred dollars one book-keeper and  
24 cashier fifteen hundred dollars transcribing clerks recording  
25 clerks inventory clerks index clerks compare clerks miscel-  
26 laneous clerks and stenographer each at twelve hundred  
27 dollars per annum custodians of records and a messenger  
28 each at one thousand dollars per annum Such salaries

1 and compensation to be paid monthly by the treasurer  
 2 of such county according to existing laws" is hereby  
 3 further amended to read as follows

4 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House  
 5 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in  
 6 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the  
 7 authority of the same That the salaries or compensation  
 8 of the deputy register clerks and employes in the office  
 9 of the register of wills of any county of this Common-  
 10 wealth having a population of one million four hundred  
 11 thousand or over as computed by the last preceding  
 12 United States census shall be as follows Deputy register  
 13 at the rate of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum  
 14 one chief clerk seventeen hundred dollars one assistant  
 15 chief clerk sixteen hundred dollars one book-keeper and  
 16 cashier fifteen hundred dollars three transcribing clerks  
 17 four recording clerks one inventory clerk four index clerks  
 18 three compare clerks two miscellaneous clerks four account  
 19 clerks two temporary clerks one search clerk and two  
 20 stenographers each at fifteen hundred dollars per annum  
 21 one messenger one messenger and custodian and two cus-  
 22 todians each at twelve hundred dollars per annum and  
 23 one janitor at one thousand dollars per annum Such sal-  
 24 aries and compensation to be paid monthly by the treas-  
 25 urer of such county according to existing laws
