AN ACT

To amend the act approved the seventh day of June one thousand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws six hundred seventy-three) entitled "An act requiring foundries to be provided with toilet-room and water-closet regulating same and providing a penalty for violation thereof" as amended by extending the provisions of the act to rolling mills boiling mills heating mills and finishing mills

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section one of the act approved the seventh day of June
5 one thousand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws six
6 hundred seventy-three) entitled "An act requiring foundries
7 to be provided with toilet-room and water-closet regulating
8 same and providing a penalty for violation thereof" which
9 as amended by the act approved the fourth day of April

1 one thousand nine hundred thirteen (Pamphlet Laws forty-
2 two) entitled "An act to amend an act approved the
3 seventh day of June one thousand nine hundred and
4 eleven entitled 'An act requiring foundries to be provided
5 with toilet-room and water-closet regulating same and pro-
6 viding a penalty for violation thereof'" reads as follows
7 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
8 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
9 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
10 authority of the same That every person firm or cor-
11 poration being the owner or lessee of any foundry for
12 the casting of iron steel brass or other metal wherein
13 ten or more men shall be employed shall cause to be
14 established and maintained in a place conveniently acces-
15 sible and connected with said foundry in such a manner
16 that access thereto can be had without exposure to the
17 open air a toilet-room of suitable size wherein said em-
18 ployes may change their clothes Such toilet-room shall be
19 provided with wash-bowls sinks or other suitable fixed ap-
20 pliances duly connected and supplied with running hot and
21 cold water There shall also be established and maintained
22 separate from said toilet-room a suitable water-closet It
23 shall be the duty of the factory inspector or his duly
24 authorized agent to enforce the provisions of this act
25 For that purpose the factory inspector or his duly author-
26 ized agent may enter at any reasonable time any foundry
27 for the purpose of inspecting the same to ascertain
28 whether the provisions of this act have been complied
29 with" is hereby further amended to read as follows

1 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
2 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
3 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
4 authority of the same That every person firm or cor-
5 poration being the owner or lessee of any foundry for
6 the casting of iron steel brass or other metal or any
7 rolling mill boiling mill heating mill or finishing mill
8 wherein ten or more men shall be employed shall cause
9 to be established and maintained in a place conveniently
10 accessible and connected with said foundry rolling mill
11 boiling mill heating mill or finishing mill in such a
12 manner that access thereto can be had without exposure
13 to the open air a toilet-room of suitable size wherein
14 said employes may change their clothes Such toilet-room
15 shall be provided with wash-bowls sinks or other suitable
16 fixed appliances duly connected and supplied with running
17 hot and cold water There shall also be established and
18 maintained separate from said toilet-room a suitable water-
19 closet It shall be the duty of the factory inspector or
20 his duly authorized agent to enforce the provisions of
21 this act For that purpose the factory inspector or his
22 duly authorized agent may enter at any reasonable time
23 any foundry rolling mill boiling mill heating mill or
24 finishing mill for the purpose of inspecting the same to
25 ascertain whether the provisions of this act have been
26 complied with

27 Section 2 Section two of said act which reads as
28 follows

1 "Section 2 The said toilet-room and the said water-
2 closet shall be connected with the foundry building in
3 such a way that access thereto may be had without ex-
4 posure to the open air and shall be properly heated
5 ventilated cleaned and protected so far as reasonably prac-
6 ticable from the dust of such foundry" is hereby amended
7 to read as follows

8 Section 2 The said toilet-room and the said water-
9 closet shall be connected with the foundry rolling mill
10 boiling mill heating mill or finishing mill building in
11 such a way that access thereto may be had without ex-
12 posure to the open air and shall be properly heated
13 ventilated cleaned and protected so far as reasonably
14 practicable from the dust of such building.
