## FILE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

INTRODUCED BY MR. GANS, MARCH 17, 1919.

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION, MARCH 18, 1919.

## AN ACT

Relating to eggs prohibiting the sale offering for sale exposing for sale or having in possession with intent to sell eggs for and as fresh that are not fresh eggs or of branding or of labeling or marking eggs as being fresh eggs that are not fresh eggs prescribing certain duties of the Dairy and Food Commissioner in reference thereto and providing penalties for the violation thereof

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *it shall be unlawful for any person firm or corporate*  
5 *body by himself herself or themselves or by his her or*  
6 *their agents or servants to sell expose for sale or have*  
7 *in his her or their possession with intent to sell any*  
8 *eggs for and as fresh eggs that are not fresh eggs as*  
9 *may appear upon proper test*

1 Section 2 Eggs shall be deemed to be misbranded  
2 under this act if they are in any way branded labeled  
3 marked stamped or in any way represented as being  
4 fresh eggs when they are in fact not fresh eggs as  
5 may appear upon proper test.

6 Section 3 Any person violating any of the provis-  
7 ions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and  
8 upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine  
9 of not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than fifty  
10 (\$50) dollars or upon default of payment of such fine  
11 to be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than  
12 ten days

13 Section 4 That the Dairy and Food Commissioner  
14 shall be charged with the enforcement of the provisions  
15 of this act

16 Section 5 That all fines and penalties imposed and  
17 received for the violation of any of the provisions of  
18 this act shall be paid to the Dairy and Food Commis-  
19 sioner or his agent and when so collected and paid  
20 shall thereafter be by the Dairy and Food Commissioner  
21 paid into the State Treasury for the use of the Com-  
22 monwealth

23 Section 6 This act shall in no way repeal or other-  
24 wise affect any existing laws
