**AN ACT**

Making it a felony to receive or bring or assist in receiving or bringing into the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania any stolen property and fixing a penalty

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *if any person shall receive or bring into the Common-*  
5 *wealth of Pennsylvania or aid or assist in bringing any*  
6 *goods chattels monies or securities or any other matter*  
7 *or thing knowing or having reasonable cause to know*  
8 *the same to have been stolen or feloniously taken in*  
9 *any other state or Commonwealth such person shall be*  
10 *guilty of a felony and on conviction thereof shall be*  
11 *sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred dol-*  
12 *lars and undergo an imprisonment by separate and soli-*  
13 *tary confinement at labor not exceeding three years*
