AN ACT

Fixing the salaries of certain clerks in the office of the recorder of deeds in counties having a population of one million five hundred thousand inhabitants or over

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 in all counties having a population of one million five
5 hundred thousand inhabitants or over as computed by the
6 last preceding United States census the salaries and
7 compensation of the chief deed index clerk and the chief
8 mortgage index clerk shall be at the rate of twenty-one
9 hundred dollars per annum each and the salaries and
10 compensation of the assistant chief deed index clerk and
11 the assistant chief mortgage index clerk shall be at the
12 rate of eighteen hundred dollars per annum each Such
13 salaries and compensation shall be paid monthly by the

1 treasurer of the respective county according to existing
2 laws

3 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
4 with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed
