AN ACT

To regulate advertisements and solicitations for employes during strikes or lockouts or other labor disputes

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *if any employer during the continuance of a strike*
5 *among his employes or during the continuance of a lock-*
6 *out or other labor trouble among his employes publicly adver-*
7 *tises in newspapers or by posters or otherwise for em-*
8 *ployes or by himself or his agents solicits persons to*
9 *work for him to fill the place of strikers he shall*
10 *plainly and explicitly mention in such advertisements or oral*
11 *or written solicitations that a strike lockout or other*
12 *labor disturbance exists*

13 Section 2 If any person firm association or corpora-
14 tion violates any provisions of this act he or the of-
15 ficers of such firm association or corporation shall be

1 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
2 thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one
3 hundred dollars for such offense or imprisonment of not
4 more than thirty days either or both at the discretion
5 of the court
