AN ACT

Providing a closed season on sturgeon or mamose in the Delaware River and Bay and the tributaries thereof upon the passage of similar legislation by certain states

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 hereafter it shall not be lawful for any person or per-
5 sons to take catch kill or have in possession any stur-
6 geon or mamose taken caught or killed in the Delaware
7 Bay and River or their tributaries at any time of the
8 year until the first day of March Anno Domini one
9 thousand nine hundred and twenty-four Any person or per-
10 sons violating any of the provisions of this act shall
11 be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
12 thereof shall be punished by a fine of five hundred dol-
13 lars or be imprisoned not over thirty days or both at
14 the discretion of the court

1 Section 2 This act shall take effect and be in force
2 only when similar acts have been passed by the legis-
3 latures of the States of New Jersey and Delaware
