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**AN ACT**

Authorizing fifty per centum of the registration and license fees paid by persons residing within the several boroughs for the registration of motor vehicles and drivers' licenses to be returned to the various boroughs for the purpose of constructing repairing maintaining and improving certain highways therein providing the manner in which the same shall be returned and imposing certain duties and conditions upon such boroughs in relation thereto

1      Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *from and after the thirty-first day of December one thou-*  
5 *sand nine hundred and nineteen fifty per centum of the*  
6 *moneys derived from the registration and license fees paid*  
7 *by persons residing within the several boroughs of this*  
8 *Commonwealth for the registration of motor vehicles and*  
9 *drivers' licenses shall be returned to the treasurers of*

1 the respective boroughs in which such persons reside Such  
2 moneys shall be used by the boroughs for the sole pur-  
3 pose of constructing repairing maintaining and improving  
4 the main highways within the limits of such boroughs  
5 The remaining fifty per centum of such moneys derived  
6 from such registration and license fees shall be retained  
7 by the State Treasurer and shall be available for the  
8 use of the State Highway Department for such purposes  
9 as are now provided by law.

10 Section 2 The moneys derived from the registration  
11 and license fees of the residents of the several boroughs  
12 shall be paid by the State Highway Department into the  
13 State Treasury and the return of such portion thereof  
14 to the various boroughs under the provisions of ~~this act~~  
15 shall be made quarterly by the State Treasurer upon the  
16 warrant of the Auditor General issued upon receipt of  
17 certificates from the State Highway Department showing  
18 the amount of registration and license fees received from  
19 the residents of the respective boroughs

20 Section 3 All boroughs receiving any moneys from  
21 such fees shall within one year from the date of the  
22 receipt thereof make a report to the State Highway De-  
23 partment showing that such moneys have been used and  
24 expended for the purposes as herein directed Any bor-  
25 oughs failing neglecting or refusing to make such report  
26 within such time shall not be entitled to receive any por-  
27 tion of such moneys for a period of one year there-  
28 after and shall in addition be liable to the Common-

1 wealth for the amount of such moneys previously received  
2 under the provisions of this act

3 Section 4 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-  
4 with are hereby repealed
