AN ACT

Reorganizing the Adjutant General's Department designating the officers and employes thereof and fixing the salaries of each

1 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
2 sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly
3 met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That
4 the Adjutant General's Department on and after June
5 first nineteen hundred and nineteen shall consist of the
6 bureaus and branches thereof together with officers and
7 employes named whose annual salaries are hereby fixed
8 and shall be as follows

9 The Adjutant General at a salary of seven thousand
10 five hundred (\$7,500) dollars per annum

11 The Deputy Adjutant General at a salary of three
12 thousand six hundred (\$3,600) dollars per annum

13 BUREAU OF ADMINISTRATION

14 One chief clerk who shall also be secretary to the

1 State Armory Board at a salary of three thousand six  
2 hundred (\$3,600) dollars per annum

3 One file clerk at a salary of one thousand four  
4 hundred (\$1,400) dollars per annum

7 One stenographer who shall also be stenographer to  
8 the State Armory Board at a salary of one thousand

7 Section 2 All employes in the office of the Adjutant  
8 General and in the State arsenal shall be appointed by  
9 the Adjutant General who is hereby authorized to make  
10 such assignments to duty and to change or alter such  
11 assignments as may in his judgment be necessary to  
12 subserve the interests of the Commonwealth

13 Section 3 All salaries provided for in this act shall  
14 be paid as now provided by law

15 Section 4 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-  
16 with be and the same are hereby repealed
