## AN ACT

To amend section twelve of an act approved the eighteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (Pamphlet Laws two hundred and three) entitled "An act to provide for the more effectual protection of the public health in the several municipalities of this Commonwealth" by imposing certain duties upon boards of school directors in relation to vaccination

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 section twelve of an act approved the eighteenth day of  
5 June one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (Pamphlet  
6 Laws two hundred and three) entitled "An act to pro-  
7 vide for the more effectual protection of the public  
8 health in the several municipalities of this Commonwealth"  
9 which reads as follows

10 "Section 12 All principals or other persons in charge

1 of schools as aforesaid are hereby required to refuse the  
2 admission of any child to the schools under their charge  
3 or supervision except upon a certificate signed by a physi-  
4 cian setting forth that such child has been successfully  
5 vaccinated or that it has previously had small-pox" is  
6 hereby amended to read as follows

7 Section 12 All principals or other persons in charge  
8 of schools as aforesaid are hereby required to notify the  
9 school directors of the school district in which the school  
10 is located of any child in the school under his or her  
11 supervision who has not presented a certificate signed by  
12 a physician setting forth that such child has been suc-  
13 cessfully vaccinated or that he or she has previously had  
14 small-pox Thereupon it shall be the duty of the board  
15 of school directors to expel such child from such school
