AN ACT

To amend section one of an act approved the fourteenth day of April one thousand nine hundred and three entitled "An act relating to change of polling places and authorizing the commissioners to change the same"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *an act entitled "An act relating to change of polling*
5 *places and authorizing the County Commissioners to change*
6 *the same" approved the fourteenth day of April one thou-*
7 *sand nine hundred and three be and the same is hereby*
8 *amended as follows That section one of said act which now*
9 *reads as follows*

10 "Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
11 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
12 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That it*
13 *shall be lawful for the county commissioners of any county of this*
14 *Commonwealth at any time at least three weeks prior to*

1 any general municipal township or special election for any
2 reason that may seem proper to the county commissioners
3 upon a petition of at least ten qualified electors of any
4 township election division to change the polling place of
5 said township or election division Provided however that the
6 said county commissioners may in their discretion direct that
7 an election be held to settle the question as to where
8 the said polling place shall be located" be and the same
9 is hereby amended to read as follows

10 Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
11 Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
12 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
13 authority of the same That it shall be lawful for the
14 county commissioners of any county of this Commonwealth
15 at any time at least three weeks prior to any general
16 municipal township or special election for any reason that
17 may seem proper to the county commissioners upon a
18 petition of at least ten qualified electors of any township
19 election division to change the polling place of said town-
20 ship or election division Provided however that the said
21 county commissioners shall not make any change in the
22 location of the polling place of any township or election
23 division if a petition protesting against such changed signed
24 by the majority of the qualified electors of the division
25 and sworn to by one of the qualified electors be pre-
26 sented to the said county commissioners
