AN ACT

To enforce the Eighteenth Amendment to the Constitution
of the United States.

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *from and after the sixteenth day of January Anno Domini*
5 *one thousand nine hundred and twenty any person corpor-*
6 *ation or partnership engaged in any way in the manu-*
7 *facture sale or transportation of intoxicating liquors within*
8 *the importation thereof—into or the exportation thereof*
9 *from this State for beverage purposes shall be guilty of*
10 *a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be sen-*
11 *tenced to pay a fine of not exceeding five thousand dol-*
12 *lars and to undergo imprisonment in the county jail not*
13 *exceeding twelve months or both or either at the discre-*
14 *tion of the court and all liquids for beverage purposes*
15 *which contain more than two and three quarters per cent*
16 *of alcohol by weight at sixty degrees Fahrenheit are here-*

1 by declared and shall be held to be intoxicating liquors

2 within the meaning of this act

3 Section 2 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with

4 this act are hereby repealed
