## AN ACT

Relating to and regulating motor vehicles and vehicles trailing after or propelled by motor vehicles providing for the kind and nature of tires to be used upon motor vehicles and vehicles trailing after or propelled by the same providing for violation of this act prescribing the penalties for violation of the provisions of this act

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 the term "motor-vehicle" as used in this act shall in-  
5 clude automobiles motor bicycles motorcycles trucks tractors  
6 and all other vehicles which are self-propelled or designed  
7 to be self-propelled by mechanical power except those run-  
8 ning upon or guided by rails or tracks

9 The term "person" as herein used shall include the sin-  
10 gular and plural numbers and shall embrace all individ-

1 uals of either sex whether acting on their own behalf  
2 or as members officers employees agents or other represen-  
3 tatives of any other individual or of any firm copartner-  
4 ship corporation association or artificial body of any kind  
5 or character whatsoever

6 Section 2 That on and after the first day of Janu-  
7 ary nineteen hundred and twenty it shall be unlawful for  
8 any person to operate a motor vehicle on the highways  
9 of the State of Pennsylvania unless the said motor ve-  
10 hicle and any vehicle trailing after or propelled by the  
11 same has pneumatic tires affixed or attached to the  
12 wheels thereof of sufficient size and strength to carry the  
13 said vehicle and the contents thereof

14 Section 3 The violation of any of the provisions of  
15 this act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon convic-  
16 tion thereof the person so convicted shall be sentenced to  
17 pay a fine of one thousand dollars
