AN ACT

To repeal Section three entitled "An Act relating to the fees salaries and duties of certain county officers in Allegheny County Page four hundred seventy-seven Section three Laws of Pennsylvania Number one thousand eight hundred seventy-one"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 Section three of the Act entitled "An act relating to
5 the fees salaries and duties of certain County officers in
6 Allegheny County" approved April sixth one thousand eight
7 hundred seventy-one Page four hundred seventy-seven reading
8 as follows

9 "Section 3 That the notice required to be given by
10 the sheriff of said county of all judicial sales by him
11 to be made shall be by printed hand-bills fully describ-
12 ing the property to be sold according to levy with its

1 improvements one of which shall be posted in a con-
2 spicuous place in his office and one on or near the
3 property to be sold and also by advertisements published
4 three times before the day of sale once in each con-
5 secutive week in one daily English and in one daily
6 German newspaper printed in the city of Pittsburgh des-
7 ignating briefly the locality and quantity of the property
8 to be sold the name of owner on what writ the time
9 when and the place where it is to be sold and
10 such advertisement and publication shall be deemed proper
11 and sufficient and to have the force and effect of such
12 as are now required by law in like cases and before
13 a warrant can be drawn on the county Treasurer in
14 favor of the proprietor or proprietors of any newspaper
15 to whom the sheriff or any other officer herein named
16 shall give out the printing and publication of sheriff
17 sales advertisements and legal notices he or they must
18 file with the controller of said county a sworn itemized
19 bill or statement of the printing and advertising afore-
20 said and that the charges therefor do not exceed the
21 usual and ordinary rates for advertising such notices
22 which bill shall be approved by said controller and paid
23 by the said treasurer on proper warrant" be and the
24 same is hereby repealed
