AN ACT

To amend section ninety-two of Article nine of an act approved the twenty-eighth day of July one thousand nine hundred seventeen (Pamphlet Laws one thousand two hundred and fifteen) entitled "An act to revise amend and consolidate the law relating to fish and providing penalties"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section ninety-two of Article nine of an act approved the
5 twenty-eighth day of July one thousand nine hundred and
6 seventeen (Pamphlet Laws one thousand two hundred and
7 fifteen) entitled "An act to revise amend and consolidate
8 the law relating to fish and providing penalties" which
9 reads as follows

10 "Section 92 No person shall fish except with a rod
11 hook and line within one hundred feet of the lower end
12 of any fishway or dam or within such other distance

1 as the Commissioner of Fisheries may determine Such dis-
2 tance shall be plainly posted on the fishway or adjacent
3 shore Any person violating the provisions of this section
4 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction as pro-
5 vided in article thirteen of this act shall be sentenced
6 to pay a fine of one hundred dollars" is hereby amended
7 to read as follows

8 Section 92 No person shall fish except with a rod
9 hook and line within one hundred feet of the lower end
10 of any fishway or dam or within such other distance as
11 the Commissioner of Fisheries may determine Such distance
12 shall be plainly posted on the fishway or adjacent shore
13 Provided That fishing in the Susquehanna river at the
14 McCall's Ferry dam shall be permitted up to the lower
15 end of the dam without restriction or limitation by order
16 or regulation of the Commissioner of Fisheries Any person
17 violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a
18 misdemeanor and on conviction as provided in article thir-
19 teen of this act shall be sentenced to pay a fine of
20 one hundred dollars
