AN ACT

To amend section twelve of an act approved the eighteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (Pamphlet Laws two hundred and three) entitled "An act to provide for the more effectual protection of the public health in the several municipalities of this Commonwealth"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section twelve of an act approved the eighteenth day of
5 June one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (Pamphlet
6 Laws two hundred and three) entitled "An act to provide for the
7 more effectual protection of the public health in the several
8 municipalities of this Commonwealth" which reads as fol-
9 lows

10 "Section 12 All principals or other persons in charge
11 of schools as aforesaid are hereby required to refuse the
12 admission of any child to the schools under their charge

1 or supervision except upon a certificate signed by a phy-
2 sician setting forth that such child has been successfully
3 vaccinated or that it has previously had small-pox" is
4 hereby amended to read as follows

5 Section 12 All principals or other persons in charge
6 of schools as aforesaid are hereby required to report to
7 the Board or Bureau of Health or the health authorities
8 of the city borough town or township or if there be
9 no such board or bureau or health authorities then to
10 the Commissioner of Health any child in his or her
11 school who has not presented a certificate signed by a
12 physician setting forth that such child has been success-
13 fully vaccinated or that he or she has previously had
14 small-pox Thereupon the Board or Bureau of health the
15 health authorities or the Commissioner of Health as the
16 case may be shall suspend such child from such school
17 until such certificate shall have been presented
