AN ACT

Authorizing the payment of fifty dollars to all Pennsylvania soldiers and sailors by the State of Pennsylvania who have been inducted into the Army or Navy of the United States from the State of Pennsylvania since the commencement of the war upon their honorable discharge

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *upon the honorable discharge of any soldier or sailor*
5 *who has been inducted into the Army or Navy of the*
6 *United States from the State of Pennsylvania since the*
7 *commencement of the present war the State of Pennsyl-*
8 *vania shall pay to said soldier or sailor the sum of*
9 *fifty dollars upon his honorable discharge and the filing*
10 *of a certificate thereof with the Auditor General*

11 Section 2 Upon the passage of this act the Auditor

1 General is directed to make a report to the Senate and
2 House of Representatives of a method by which the funds
3 to carry out the provisions of this act shall be raised
