AN ACT

Fixing the salaries and compensation of the officers clerks and employes in the office of the recorder of deeds of any county having a population of one million five hundred thousand inhabitants or over

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *the salaries and compensation of the officers clerks and*
5 *employes in the office of the recorder of deeds of any*
6 *county containing a population of one million five hundred*
7 *thousand inhabitants or over as computed by the last pre-*
8 *ceding United States census shall be at the following*
9 *rate per annum*

22 Such salaries and compensation shall be paid by the
 23 treasurer of the respective county out of the fees of
 24 such office as provided by law

25 Section 2 The act approved the tenth day of May
 26 one thousand nine hundred nine (Pamphlet Laws five hun-
 27 dred and five) entitled "An act to fix the salaries of the
 28 miscellaneous clerks special clerks temporary clerks assistant
 29 temporary clerks transcribing clerks and copyists in the

1 office of the recorder of deeds of any county of this
2 Commonwealth having a population of one million or over"
3 and the act approved the fifth day of May one thou-
4 sand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws one hundred and
5 ninety-six) entitled "An act to amend the first section of
6 an act approved the tenth day of May Anno Domini one
7 thousand nine hundred and nine entitled 'An act to fix
8 the salaries of the miscellaneous clerks special clerks tem-
9 porary clerks assistant temporary clerks transcribing clerks
10 and copyists in the office of the recorder of deeds of
11 any county of this Commonwealth having a population of
12 one million or over' so as to make it apply to coun-
13 ties having a population of one million four hundred thou-
14 sand or over" are hereby repealed All other acts and
15 parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act
16 are hereby repealed
