INTRODUCED BY MR. STADTLANDER, MARCH 31, 1919.

AN ACT

Being a supplement to an act entitled "An act for the government of cities of the second class" approved the seventh day of March Anno Domini nineteen hundred and one authorizing the licensing and regulation of persons carrying on the business of taking receiving boarding or keeping infant children under the age of three years for hire and providing penalties for the violation hereof.

1 Section . 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *the Director of the Department of Public Health in*
5 *cities of the second class is hereby authorized to license*
6 *annually persons engaged in the business of taking, receiy-*
7 *ing boarding or keeping infant children under the age*
8 *of three years for hire or reward in a certain place*
9 *to be designated in the license*

10 Section 2 Such licenses shall only be issued by said

1 director after investigation as to the moral qualifications
2 of the proposed license and the sanitary healthful and
3 comfortable condition of the premises in which the pro-
4 posed licensee intends to carry on said business

5 Section 3 Each licensee shall pay for said annual
6 license the sum of five dollars and no person shall
7 engage in said business in cities of the second class
8 without having first obtained a license as aforesaid

9 Section 4 The Director of the Department of Public
10 Health in said cities of the second class by his duly
11 authorized agents shall have the right at all reasonable
12 times to inspect the premises where the said licensee is
13 authorized to carry on said business and to revoke the
14 said license for violation of any regulations of said De-
15 partment of Public Health or when he is satisfied it
16 is to the best interest of the public that said license
17 be revoked

18 Section 5 Any person carrying on said buisenss in
19 cities of the second class without having first received a
20 license or after the revocation of said license or its ex-
21 piration shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and
22 upon conviction thereof shall be fined not exceeding one
23 hundred dollars and imprisonment not exceeding thirty days
24 either or both

25 Section 6 That Sections two and three of the act
26 of Assembly entitled "An act supplementary to an act
27 entitled 'An act to protect children from neglect and
28 cruelty and relating to their employment protection and
29 adoption' approved the eleventh day of June eighteen hun-

1 dred and seventy-nine providing for the further protection
2 of minors and regulating the boarding and maintaining of
3 infant children for hire" approved the twenty-eighth day
4 of May eighteen hundred and eighty-five and all other
5 acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith be and the
6 same are hereby repealed insofar as they relate to cities
7 of the second class.
