AN ACT

To amend an act entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania together with the provisions by which it shall be administered and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof providing revenue to establish and maintain the same and the method of collecting such revenue and repealing all laws general special or local or any parts thereof that are or may be inconsistent therewith" by adding thereto section one thousand five hundred and twelve authorizing the directors of any school district in which a special school for pupils having tuberculosis shall be established to provide the pupils thereof with food clothing and transportation necessary for attendance thereat
